Competitive Employment Services	Rate
Referral: (STEP 1)	\$1,550
Placement: (STEP 2)	\$1,100
Closure: (STEP 3)	\$1,450
Supported Employment Services	Rate
Milestone 1 – Situational assessment and/or discovery (minimum of 2 situational assessments in an integrated setting)	\$1,200
Milestone 2 – Job search/job placement - includes job analysis and sequence of job duties	\$1,200
Milestone 3 – Job Retention	\$1,500
Milestone 4 – Case Closure	\$2,100
Extended Supports to Youth (up to 25 years of age or 4 years, whichever comes first)	\$25 per hour
Customized Employment Services	Rate
Discovery	\$1,700
IPS-SAMHA Services	Rate
Currently Working on a Fee Structure for Sustainability and Expansion - Anticipate a milestone payment structure similar to supported employment	Current providers are grant funded
Other Services	Rate
Project SEARCH	Paid through contracts
Transition to Success (for Youth with Autism)	Paid through contracts
GATE - Gaining Access to Employment (Pre-Employment Job Training)	Braided funding with ADMH (Medicaid). ADRS pays MS1 ADMH pays on site pre-employment job coaches, ADMH pays MS 2-4 (post employment coaching) ADMH pays long term follow up
Career Assessment	Can vary from \$200, up to \$1500 depending on the nature of the evaluation. The low end pricing are generally vocational assessments with transition students, the higher end are situational evaluations in a rehabilitation center.
Smart Work Ethics (a social skills curriculum)	\$1,200
JET (Job Exploration Training)	\$127.50 a day - This is a combination of job readiness and community work experience. It is usually a 2-4 week program during the summer.
