<p>Off-Site Services – Travel and Mileage Reimbursement: In an effort to serve DOR consumers for whom travel to a CRP location may be impractical or impossible, the SVRC may authorize travel and/or mileage reimbursements to a CRP who will travel to conduct off-site services to a DOR consumer. CRPs must follow travel policies in place for the organization. However, rates reimbursed to the organization shall not exceed the maximum state rates as indicated on the Department of Personnel Administration (DPA) website. Supporting documentation must be maintained to support the actual costs billed.
