Supported Employment Services	Rate
Milestone 1 - Job Development/Placement	\$2,000
Milestone 2 - One Month Job Retention	\$1,000
Milestone 3 - Job Stabilization/Transition to Extended Follow Along	\$1,000
Milestone 4 - Successful Case Closure	\$2,250
High Quality Indicators (If two of the following are met: 25 or more hours per week, wage at or above \$10/hour, health insurance benefits available)	Additional \$1000 at the time of Milestone 4 payment
Job Readiness, Development and Placement Services	Rate
Job Readiness Training	\$50.00 per day for a maximum of 30 days (maximum of \$1,500 per consumer)
Job Placement	\$1,000.00 payable after the 7th day of employment and \$1,500.00 payable after the 90th day of successful employment
High Quality Indicators (If two of the following are met: 30 or more hours per week, wage at or above \$12/hour, health insurance benefits available)	\$1,000
Time-Limited Job Coaching Services*	Rate
Milestone 1 - Job Development/Placement	\$2,000
Milestone 2 - One Month Job Retention	\$500
Milestone 3 - Two Months Job Retention	\$500
Milestone 4 - Successful Case Closure (at least 90 days of satisfactory employment)	\$2,250
High Quality Indicators (If two of the following are met: 25 or more hours per week, wage at or above \$10/hour, health insurance benefits available)	\$1,000

Transition from School to Work Services	Rate
Workplace Readiness Training and Instruction on Self Advocacy	\$496.00 per month (\$4,464.00 maximum per consumer per school year) or Prorated fees: 1-3 days = ¼ month or \$124.00, 4-6 days = ½ month or \$248.00, 7-9 days = ¾ month or \$372.00, 10 or more days = 1 full month or \$496.00
Work-Based Learning Experiences - Paid	The rate of reimbursement is equal to the consumer’s monthly base salary up to \$8.00 per hour. Reimbursement cannot exceed 480 hours for the school year per student. Reimbursement is made up to a forty (40) hour work week.
Work-Based Learning Experiences - Paid and Unpaid to a CRP/vendor	\$500.00 per experience, for up to two experiences. Cannot exceed \$1000. In addition to these fees for placing the consumer into a WBLE, the CRP/vendor will be paid for each month the consumer maintains the WBLE. Fees can be billed by the vendor at the end of each 30 day period that the consumer maintains the WBLE for up to three months. The vendor must provide documentation of the number of days the consumer attended the WBLE (WBLE - 1). Rate: 1st month = \$500.00, 2nd month = \$500.00, 3rd month = \$500.00, Total Rate: \$2,500.00 (Maximum per consumer including two placement rates of \$500 and payment for three months that student maintains WBLE at \$500.00 each month)
Other Services	Rate
On the Job Training	To employer - rate of monthly base salary, 40 hours a week, not to exceed 3 months
<p>* Time Limited Job Coaching is for individuals with significant disabilities who do not require extended follow-along services but need short-term job training and support(s). In addition, Time-Limited Job Coaching does not require the same length of job training as supported employment. Time-Limited Job Coaching is viewed as a level of training slightly more intensive than on-the-job training and less intensive than supported employment training.</p>
