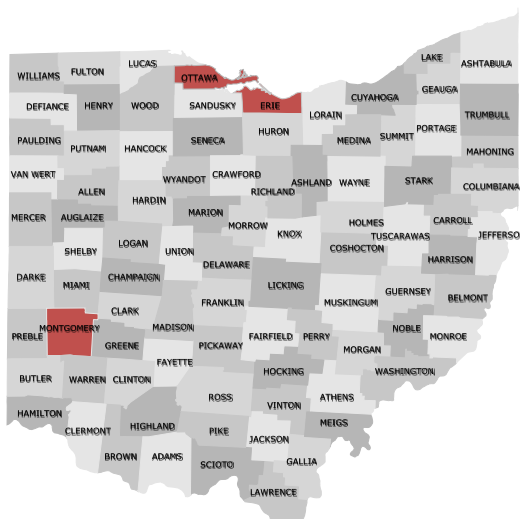

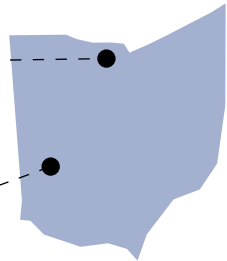
### SEP PURPOSE
